1 Introduction

MMBase is a Web Content Management System with strong multimedia features and advanced portal functionalities. Broadcasters, publishers, educational institutes, etc can use it. MMBase is written in Java, it is Open Source (MPL). The system can be used with all major operating systems, application servers and databases. For more information, visit <http://www.mmbase.org/>.

In this document, we will learn how to deploy MMBase on Pramati Server 4.1 and access the portal.

2 Requirements

To use MMBase with Pramati Server:

- Download and Install Pramati Server 4.1 from Pramati website. For this document, we will use Pramati Server 4.1 SP1.
- Download MMBase from <http://www.mmbase.org/>. For this document, we will use mmbase-1.7.3.zip.

3 Deploying and Accessing MMBase Application

Unzip mmbase-1.7.3.zip and extract the files to a temporary folder. To deploy the application:

1. Copy mmbase-webapp folder to the public_html folder located at `<install_dir>/server/nodes/<$NODE-NAME>/archives/public-html`.
2. Start Server.
3. To access the application, open the URL: <http://<IP>:<PORT>/mmbase-webapp/version> in your browser. For example: <http://localhost:8181/mmbase-webapp/1.7.3>. The page isn't displayed now. To view details, check MMBase log files.
4. Refresh the page to view the MMBase page.
5. To access the admin page, open the URL: <http://localhost:8181/mmbase-webapp/mmbase/admin/index.jsp>.

6. Click ADMIN and enter username as admin and password as admin2k. This logs you in as admin.
